NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Project Title:

California Lost Fishing Gear Recovery Project

Project Location:

California state marine waters from the Oregon border to the border with Mexico including coastal bays such as San Francisco and San Diego and from the intertidal zone to a maximum water depth of 400

feet.

County:

All coastal and San Francisco Bay counties

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code Section 2100 et seq.), the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14 Code of Regulations Section 1500 et seq.), and the University of California Procedures for the Implementation of CEQA, a Draft Initial Study for the abovenamed project was prepared (please see enclosure). The document identifies and evaluates the potential environmental impacts of the proposed project. The university proposes to prepare a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project.

Project Description

The proposed project would be located in state marine waters of California off the approximately 1,100-mile coastline from the Oregon border to the international border with Mexico and from the intertidal zone to maximum water depth of 400 feet. UC Davis will operate a program to remove lost fishing gear from state marine waters in order to improve habitat and recreational resources. The project will include recovery efforts of lost fishing using underwater divers and a support vessel. The Initial Study identifies one potentially significant impact to the White abalone (*Haliotus sorensi*) and incorporates a mitigation measure to decrease the potential impact to a less-than-significant level.

Environmental Review and Comment

The Draft Initial Study for the proposed project was prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), state and University of California guidelines for implementation of CEQA. Based on the analysis presented in the Draft Initial Study, it has been determined that one potentially significant impact could result from potential disturbance to the White abalone (*Haliotus sorensi*). However, the inclusion of a mitigation measure would reduce this potential impact to a less-than-significant level by avoiding all contact and disturbance to the White abalone. Based on the analysis in the Initial Study, the University of California has determined that a Mitigated Negative Declaration will be prepared for this project.

The Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration for the proposed project will be circulated for public and agency review from July 3, 2008 to August 1, 2008.
