**Project Title:** Landfill Operations Changes  
**Project Location:** West Campus, University of California Davis, Yolo County

**Project Description:** UC Davis collects campus-generated municipal solid waste (MSW) and disposes it at a campus-operated landfill. Construction, operation, closure and post-closure maintenance activities campus landfill were approved in July 1995 and analyzed in the Final EIR for the UC Davis Landfill Expansion and Permit Revision ("Landfill FEIR") (State Clearinghouse No. 1993081104). That expansion was estimated to provide MSW disposal capacity for UC Davis through approximately 2040, at which time final landfill closure was anticipated. Proposed changes to current MSW collection and landfill operations are as follows:

- Close the campus landfill in 2011-12. Daily disposal operations at the campus landfill would cease, and following final closure consistent with the campus' landfill permit only post-closure maintenance operations would continue.
- UC Davis waste collection trucks would take campus MSW to the Yolo County Central Landfill.


On November 20, 2003, The Regents of the University of California ("University") certified the Final Environmental Impact Report ("LRDP FEIR") (State Clearinghouse Number 2002102092) for the 2003 UC Davis Long Range Development Plan ("LRDP"). The 2003 LRDP Final EIR evaluated the program-level impacts from projected campus growth between 2003 and 2015. The LRDP FEIR contemplated that UC Davis would use the campus landfill for disposal of campus MSW through the 2015-16 LRDP planning horizon and beyond.

The Fish and Game Fee was paid at the time of the certification of the LRDP EIR (SCH #2002102092); a copy of the receipt is attached.

This is to advise that the University of California (Lead Agency) has approved the above-described project on August 25, 2011, and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment
2. Addendum #2 to the 2003 UC Davis LRDP Final EIR and addendum #1 to the Landfill Expansion and Permit Revision Final EIR have been prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA and together with the 2003 LRDP Final EIR and the Landfill Expansion Final EIR, fully analyze the impacts of the project.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
5. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
