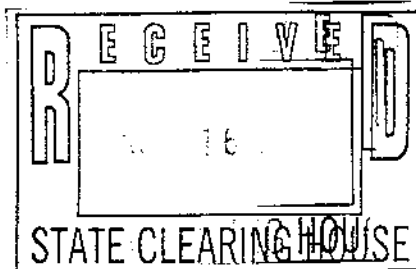

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION — NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Project Title: Segundo Infill Housing
State Clearinghouse Number: 2001092063
Project Location: University of California, Davis
County: Yolo

Project Description: The proposed project is to construct 370 beds of freshman student housing and 10 beds for resident advisors, as well as lounges and study areas. The project consists of three buildings, each four stories tall. Individual rooms are arranged in clusters of 8 students, sharing a common bath. The project will be fully sprinklered throughout.

The proposed project is located in the present Parking Lot 23, at the corner of La Rue Road and Russell Boulevard.


In compliance with State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (Section 21108), as amended, and with the University of California environmental procedures, the University hereby declares that it has approved the above-named project.

Based upon the information contained in the Initial Study, it has been determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment. Consequently, no EIR has been prepared on the project, pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. The Negative Declaration/Initial Study for the project completed State review on October 17, 2001, and was approved by the University on November 15, 2001.
