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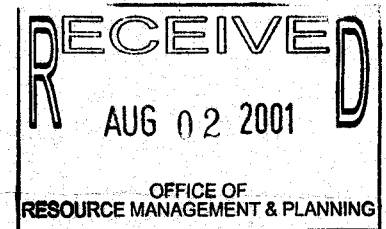

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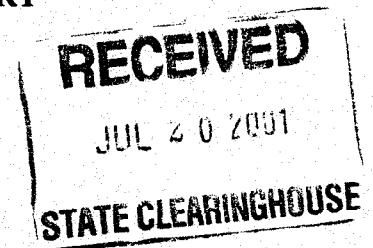

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

Project Description:

The proposed Veterinary Medicine 3A (Vet Med 3A) facility is designed to contain 90,635 assignable square feet of new construction and 5,455 assignable square feet of remodeled space in the existing Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospital. The total project area is 165,583 gross square feet. Vet Med 3A will include a five-story research tower and one-and two-story clinical and teaching laboratories.

The proposed site of the project is within the Health Sciences sub-district of the Davis campus, just east of Hwy 113. The project site is east of the Veterinary Medicine Diagnostic Laboratory and north of the Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21108), and with the University of California Procedures for Implementation of CEQA, the University hereby declares that it has approved the above-named project.

Pursuant to the provisions of CEQA, an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared for a number of projects in the Health Sciences area, called the Veterinary Medicine Facilities Improvement Project EIR. The project was assigned State Clearinghouse Number SCH 200009212, and the Draft EIR completed State Clearinghouse review on December 13, 2000.


It has been determined that this project as mitigated will have a significant effect on the environment. On March 15, 2001, The Regents of the University of California certified the

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Veterinary Medicine Facilities Improvement Project EIR, which included evaluation of this project, adopted mitigation measures as a condition of project approval. On July 19, 2001, The Regents adopted Findings related specifically to the Vet. Med. 3A project and approved the design of the project, based on the previous certification of the Veterinary Medicine Facilities Improvement Project EIR. All significant unavoidable impacts of the project were identified in the 1994 LRDP EIR and The Regents adopted a Statement of Overriding Considerations for these impacts at that time.

In compliance with CEQA, a copy of the Final EIR has been and a copy of this NOD will be transmitted to the Davis Community Development Department.
