The project is designed to contain approximately 55,500 gross square feet in a two (2) story structure that will house auditoria, multi-media classrooms, specialty clinical teaching laboratories, seminar rooms, computer laboratory, offices, student commons and study rooms, and support spaces. The project was evaluated in the Veterinary Medicine Facilities Improvement Project (SCH #2000092012), which was certified in March 2001 in conjunction with the approval of the Center for Companion Animal Health.

This is to advise that the University of California has approved the above described-project on September 19, 2002



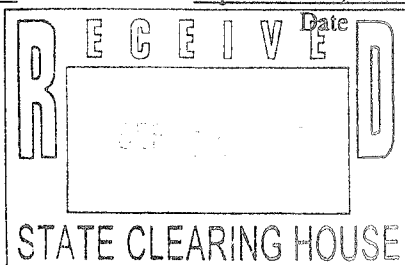
